### COURSE DESCRIPTION AND DURATION

The Erasmus Mundus CLE Master's Course has been selected in July 2018 by the European Commission under the Erasmus + programme for the Key Action 1 Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees and is based on a two-year programme (120 ECTS) with 4 semesters of 30 ECTS according to the jointed curriculum.

As a consequence of the student's selection by the CLE Selection Board, the student understands and accepts that:

## PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

- She/he will enroll at the Home University and at the Host University during the mobility as a **full time** student for the full length of the Master Course (23 months);
- She/he will **regularly attend** classes and all the program's activities and will comply with the study plan agreed. Attendance of at least 90% of the lessons is a compulsory requirement of this course;
- She/he will follow the **mobility plan agreed** with the CLE Consortium: no changes are allowed;
- In order to move and attend courses in the host institution, she/he commits her/himself:
  - to pass **all exams** of the CLE study plan established for the first academic year (to move to the host institution for the third semester) and
  - to pass all exams of the CLE study plan established for the third semester (to move to the host institution for the fourth semester);
- She/he will move from one consortium institution to the other immediately at the end of the mobility period (after the first academic year or the third semester) according to her/his mobility plan;
- The thesis will be checked using an **anti-plagiarism software**;

- She/he will discuss her/his **final thesis** during the summer session of the second academic year (July). The student is aware that the respect of these dates is a basic condition for receiving the Erasmus Mundus CLE multiple degree. - The participation of the student in the programme **surveys/evaluations** as well as the joining of the Erasmus Mundus Students and Alumni Association (**EMA**, see <http://www.em-a.eu/>) is mandatory.

**NOTA BENE – COVID-19 global pandemic**

- Admission. Final admission to enrollment is subject to verification of the authenticity, the accreditation, the level and the academic rights of the qualifications by the CLE Office in Bologna once the original documents have been received. Documents must reach the CLE by September 1, 2021. A late documents arrival due to the delays linked to the COVID-19 pandemic will be accepted if **duly justified**.
- Beginning of the First semester A.Y. 2021-22. Late students arrivals due to the delays linked to the COVID-19 will be accepted if related to governmental restrictive measures and health COVID-19 problems provided that **appropriate supporting documents** are submitted showing the impossibility to travel. This exceptional situation will be accepted if directly and exclusively linked to the COVID-19 pandemic and until the student is able to leave her country.
- Teaching activities. For the first semester of the A.Y. 2021-22 as long as Covid-19 related governmental restrictive measures are enforced in the Home University country, lectures and exams sessions will be guaranteed online. It will also be possible to attend face-to-face courses, if the health and national authorities in the Home University country allow it and in compliance with the recommendations they provide.

**DEGREES TO BE AWARDED**

Upon completion of the CLE programme, the Student is awarded with two or three Master's degrees from the universities in which she/he has studied. The degrees are legally recognized by the relevant national authorities. The degrees to be awarded depend on the chosen study track (see also the following link: <http://cle2.unibo.it/page/9/Degrees>)

**PARTICIPATION COSTS**

All CLE students are required to pay participation costs amounting to:

- ☐ € 3.000 per year for **Programme country** students
- ☐ € 6.000 per year for **Partner country** students

They allow them to register into the programme and to finance additional services dedicated to Erasmus Mundus students. They cover tuition and assistance with everyday issues throughout the two-year CLE

programme, examination and administrative services, insurance valid during the physical mobility period within the CLE programme, specific Erasmus Mundus CLE language courses and activities. No accommodation will be covered by the participation costs but students will be assisted by the CLE Consortium in finding it.

## SERVICES TO STUDENTS

The student will obtain assistance from the CLE consortium with all administrative formalities he/she may need, such as the period of enrolment at the universities, welcome reception, how to get the student card, accommodation information (cost of living, university residences, renting flats), procedures for opening a bank account, sports facilities as well as cultural and social events, and, if needed, the residence permit, registration with the local authorities and visa information.

## INSURANCE POLICY

The student will be covered by an insurance scheme provided by the Erasmus Mundus CLE consortium, in line with the Minimum insurance requirements set by Erasmus Mundus and available on the following website (insurance guidelines):

The insurance cover takes effect by the time the EMJMD scholarship holder starts its journey to participate in the Master Course (maximum two months prior the start of the specific intake to which the grantee is enrolled) and will remain valid until two months after the end of the same intake, unless there is a prior end of the EMJMD grantee status.

## DECLARATION ON HONOUR BY THE STUDENT

The student hereby declares on his or her honour that s/he did not previously receive another EMJMD scholarship or an Erasmus Mundus Master Course/Joint Doctorate scholarship.

S/He is aware about the consequences in case of false declarations (namely reimbursement of scholarships unduly paid) and that the Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency will perform regular checks to ensure the respect of the above-mentioned rule.

The Student shall comply at all times with all laws, regulations, codes of practice and directions issued by any competent authorities, which shall include without limitation the CLE full Partner Institutions/Associated partners which are applicable to (a) the study programme being carried out by the

student; or (b) the student's presence in or on land or buildings owned, occupied or under the control of the CLE full Partner Institutions/Associated partners. The Student understands that he/she shall be excluded from the CLE programme:

- I. In case of non-attendance to the CLE programme: courses, seminars, specific activities, information sessions and official meetings (attendance of at least 90% of the lessons is a compulsory requirement of this course) that the student cannot justify with medical certificates ;
- II. If the Student is the subject of disciplinary measures leading to his/her exclusion from the CLE consortium institutions;
- III. If the Student is the subject of legal prosecutions that prevent him/her from attending the CLE programme;
- IV. If the Student withdraws from the CLE programme, on his/her own decision or by force majeure;
- V. If the Student does not achieve satisfactory academic results.

**Failure to comply with the conditions laid down in the present student agreement can be a reason for the coordinating institution to dissolve the contract.**

The signatories declare that they have read all the above statements, and accept all terms and conditions laid down in the present agreement.
