





The student Visa is valid for multiple entries each academic year.




Foreign students can open a bank accounts in Indian banks with the help of the following documents - passport, proof of status - an NRI, PIO or OCI document, proof of current address such as a recent utility bill, bank statements, correspondence with a government department or authority, proof of permanent address (Indian or overseas), driving license (if it bears your address), or passport for example and passport photos.

A few banks near the University of Mumbai (Kalina campus) are IndusInd bank, Bank of Baroda and ICICI bank.










# University enrolment





### Accommodation















### Travel


